

# CHILD PROTECTION POLICY

Aqua Park AD (Action Aquapark & Aqua Nevis ClubHotel) aims to be an organization that makes a difference in the industry by applying efficiently the requirements of Quality, Food Safety and Guest Satisfaction, Occupational Health and Safety and Environmental Management Systems, sustainable environmental practices and expert staff. We have adopted a continuous improvement approach based on legal requirements and to protect the interest of all shareholders.

Aqua Park AD Child Protection policy and commitment is to protect the rights of children, with regard to their physical and mental balance, including their protection from abuse and sexual exploitation. (A child is defined as any person under the age of 18 years). Therefore we are:

- ✓ Valuing, respecting and listening to children;
- ✓ Ensuring all necessary checks are made when recruiting staff;
- ✓ Maintaining strong child protection systems and procedures for staff;
- ✓ Training our staff and providing a common understanding of child protection issues to inform planning and practice;
- ✓ Sharing information about child protection and good practice with children and parents/carers;
- ✓ Sharing information about concerns with agencies who need to know, and involving parents and children appropriately;
- ✓ Providing effective management for staff through clear processes, supervision, and support;
- ✓ We will provide adequate and appropriate resources to implement this policy and will ensure it is communicated and understood.
